LMRCC Scale Crawler Competitions Association (LMRCC) is a club that supports owners of every model, size and shape of Radio Controlled (RC) Scale truck and crawler. We want everyone from the hardcore RC crawler enthusiast to the new RC family member with their first RC crawler to be able to come out and enjoy a day rock crawling or trail running, or even just come out to watch and see what we are all about.

The LMRCC is a social club which holds competitions on public and private property and for this reason we must maintain a code of conduct for all members. Our code of conduct is in place to respect other members, the public, and the locations we hold events at. Even on non-comp days it reflects on us as an RC Society. Let's not ever be seen as a nuisance but an ambassador to RCing!

This is a fun, exciting club, run by volunteers. All funds raised through memberships, comp fees and other methods go into paying operational costs, club equipment, supplies and prizes etc.. HOUSEKEEPING

As we are holding events on public and private property it is every member's duty to respect our environment

LITTERING AND GARBAGE:

Just like the 1:1 Four-wheeler clubs "Pack Out more than you Pack In!" If you bring in wrappers, containers, drinks etc. make sure it does not get left behind. Clear the grounds when you leave. If you see someone else's garbage pick it up too! As a member we urge you to do the same when out and about on your own or with your local Get-Togethers! Public image is everything, don't leave garbage (Yours or somebody else's).

ENVIRONMENT:

By nature of our activity, we are out in "nature!" As a club we will endeavour to leave the environment in the same way we arrived. Ourselves and RC vehicles can have an impact on erosion, fish, and wildlife habitats if we are careless or operate our RCs abusively. Please minimize your impact. While in public spaces do not uproot trees or move break boulders, damage established growth etc, to create a course or to find that new line. Let us use the environment as it is, there is plenty of terrain to fulfill a fun day of competition or trailing.

BULLYING, HARASSMENT AND PROFANITY:

BULLYING, HARASSMENT:

Bullying, harassment, goading and any forms of distraction towards the public or other club members will not be tolerated in any way. If you feel any other person is acting out of line, please address it with that individual immediately. If you feel

uncomfortable approaching the individual, please address the matter with an LMRCC executive member. The executive member will address the issue immediately and request the individual to stop the behaviour. If the behaviour persists and/or it has seriously affected others, the person will be instructed to leave the competition. If asked to leave no points will be awarded for any courses they have run that day. In the very unlikely event, the individual refuses to leave and they are a member, their membership will be reviewed by the LMRCC executive board members and revoked. This person will not be permitted to attend any events for the remainder of the season.

PROFANITY:

With a competitive environment, comes tension and frustration. We understand tempers can flare and our vocabulary can be reduced to less than desirable language. Please make all attempts to curb the use of profanities, especially being in public spaces and with kids around. We all let profanities slip out occasionally, but be mindful, others may not accept the same use of vocabulary as you. If a member persists in the use of profane or vulgar language, they will be addressed in the same manner as outlined in the bullying and harassment section.

DRUGS, ALCOHOL AND SMOKING

DRUGS AND ALCOHOL:

We are an all-ages group and for this reason we must respect that. LMRCC as a social club recognizes that its members are free to do as they choose. However, all members must abide by local law. If you choose to partake in drugs or alcohol, in accordance with local law, we ask that you do so discreetly and not on the competition course and away from comp and public assembly areas.

LMRCC CODE OF CONDUCT

THE ROCK DEN

The “LMRCC - Rock Den”, our main events site, is located east of the Stave Falls Dam in Mission, BC. It is on a BC Hydro “right of way” within the City of Mission municipal forest, as such we must abide by policies held by both bodies bound by our agreement. Please note the following rules of the “LMRCC Rock Den”.

LMRCC ROCK DEN RULES

- No fires
- No camping
- No shooting
- “Pack out more than you pack in” - Leave it cleaner than you came (pick up after others)
- 4WD/AWD access only to parking within the rock den
 - If gates are close please park at the wide gravel shoulder 100m east of the gate or the two spots across from the gate
 - Do not park on the narrow shoulders or impede traffic along Dewdney Trunk Road.
- 14m recommended safety zone from towers.
- Do not store or place any metallic objects within 27m of towers
- No construction or modification is allowed without approval from LMRCC and the above mentioned parties. Trail building and rock clearing only permitted on right of way. Right of way stops at tree line
- No unauthorized permanent structures
- No Drones, Planes, Helicopters or other flying vehicles
- Respect all closures of the Municipal Forest that are implemented by the City of Mission.

Any members abusing the property will have their membership
revoked!**
